THIS SIDE UP

The 1969 Console Woodgrain Appliques are exact duplicates of the original Ford parts with design improvements.



Extra heatstake pins were added to ensure a more secure fit. Each of the four extra pins are marked with an "X". These pins are located in the areas where Ford had problems with the original pins breaking off. Because of the extra pins, four 5/32" holes will have to be drilled in the shifter panel. This template is provided. Please note that the pin locations are not symmetrical (like the original) so the template pattern must face upward.

Align the six existing holes with the template holes marked "A". Mark and drill the four new holes marked "X". Some of the holes may require filing for a perfect fit.

The heatstake pins are not chromeplated like the original. This allows them to melt easier, thus not breaking off as easy as the originals. If chrome is visible on the pins, we advise scraping it off with a knife/razor blade.



A combination of an automotive adhesive (3M) used along with heatstaking the pins helps achieve the most secure fit.
